



RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BALLSTON SPA, NY RECOGNIZING JUNE 20, 2025 AS WORLD REFUGEE DAY, AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER

WHEREAS, the <u>United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees</u> reports that more than 120 million people have been forcibly displaced worldwide as a result of persecution, conflict, or violence, more than at any other time in history; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 43.4 million refugees and 6.9 million asylum seekers throughout the world, people displaced from their home country who are unable to return; and

Upon thorough evaluation, it is evident that all submitted bids significantly exceed the allotted budget. Consequently, due to the substantial variance from the predicted costs, we recommend that the Village Board pass a resolution to reject all bids for the Electrical Construction Contract — Pump Station 4A and 4B Generator Installation in anticipation of a rebid of the work in the fall.
