³ It was recommended by counsel that the Board utilize a workshop, originally intended for April 2023, to determine the proper version and provisions to use. At the time of release of this Agenda, there were concerns with the current status of Trustee Baskin's unilateral revisions to the draft Ethics Code, and there was not a consensus on the potential for a workshop. As a result, three motions are being offered to be comprehensive and to comply with the Rules of Procedure: h) proposing the workshop; i) proposing a public hearing for the version originally offered by the Ethics Code Advisory Committee; and j) proposing a public hearing for one of Trustee Baskin's versions from the days preceding the Agenda's release.
