John St lost communications. Review online inseeego portal and all appears functional however the tank level and communications are not coming through; Colonial Hills is still communicating. Unfortunately, the VPN tunnel status screen of the Inseeego portal still does not accurately represent its connection as one side will show unknown or not connected while the other side will show connected, and sometimes both sides show unknown and not connected even when it is in fact connected and working (colonial connection currently). Due to no changes taking place on the PLC Programming side and no one changing the existing configurations it seems likely an external issue. Push a device reboot down from Inseeego portal to the Lowell St device. While waiting for its reboot I push a reboot down to the John St. device as well. After the devices return, the tunnel still will not connect and function. After some more looking I identify that the Lowell St device static IP address has been updated from 162.191.44.129 to 167.20.138.12. I am unsure if this was before or after the reboot. However now neither tunnel is functional. Update the parameters of the VPN tunnel on Lowell St configuration for the new IP Address. Then update the John St and Colonial ends configurations as well. This appears to have resolved the tunnels as we now show tank levels at the Lowell St PLC.

Colonial Hills communications lost after 1.5 hours the previous evening. Had Scott switch pump control to John St. Arrive at Colonial Hills and review. All appears it should be working however it is not. Tunnel status on Colonial side shows connected and shows unknown on Lowell side however this status has been found unreliable many times over. Rebuild entire VPN configuration and save and reboot device. After device comes back it again shows connected but there seems no communications over the tunnel. Reboot Lowell device through the Inseeego platform and wait for recovery. The tunnel never stopped saying connected on the Colonial device side. Once I see the Lowell device back online, I again test the tunnel with my laptop and it appears I can now get through to the Lowell PLC. Go back over to Lowell and verify data is coming through to the PLC and tank levels are working again. Also monitor John St to ensure we have not lost its communications, and all appear working again. Advise Scott to monitor as I do not show any cause for the loss of data over the tunnel and the resolution was merely rebooting Lowell device. This will not be acceptable as a long-term solution if these issues exist.

Local Law 1 of 2026

A local law amending Section 27-21 of Chapter 27, Code of Ethics, of the Code of the Village of Ballston Spa

Be It Enacted by the board of trustees of the Village of Ballston Spa that Section 27-21 of Chapter 27, Code of Ethics, be amended as follows:

§27-21: Board of Ethics

Membership

1. The Board of Ethics members shall be appointed by the Village Board of Trustees. The Board of Ethics shall consist of five members approved by a minimum of four members of the Board of Trustees.
2. Except as set forth in subparagraph 4 below, e Each of the five members of the Board of Ethics shall serve a term of four years.
3. Terms shall be staggered so that no more than three members shall have their terms end simultaneously. ~~Existing terms shall continue without interruption with the adoption of this Code.~~
4. Of the five members appointed beginning in 2026, one shall be appointed for a term of four years, one for a term of three years, two for a term of two years, and one for a term of up to one year, as follows:

One member appointed in 2026 to serve a term ending December 31, 2029.

One member appointed in 2026 to serve a term ending December 31, 2028.

Two members appointed in 2026 to serve a term ending December 31, 2027.

One member appointed in 2026 to serve a term ending December 31, 2026.

5. [renumbered] Members may not serve more than ~~be appointed for not more~~ two consecutive four-year full terms.
6. [renumbered] If a vacancy shall occur otherwise than by expiration of term, the Mayor shall appoint a new member for the unexpired term with the approval of four members of the Village Board of Trustees~~approval~~.
7. [renumbered] It is the responsibility of the Village Board of Trustees to solicit new applicants to fill current and upcoming vacancies on the Board of Ethics in a timely manner. Solicitation includes, at minimum, placing the vacancy on the Village Board of Trustees' agenda for at least one (1) meeting and on the Village of Ballston Spa website and social media until the vacancy is filled. The Board of Ethics shall conduct the initial review of applicants and then recommend to the Village Board of Trustees any

prospective members. In the event there are three or more vacancies to be filled at one time, the Mayor and one Trustee will conduct the initial review and then recommend to the Village Board of Trustees any prospective members.

8. [renumbered] The Village Board of Trustees has the discretion to accept or reject the recommendations of the Board of Ethics regarding the appointment of prospective new members.

If adopted, Local Law No. 1 of 2026 would amend Section 27-21 of Chapter 27, Code of Ethics, of the Code of the Village of Ballston Spa by (1) providing authority to the Board of Trustees to appoint members of the Ethics Board in 2026 for specific staggered terms as a result of multiple current vacancies, (2) providing authority to the Mayor and one Trustee, in the event that there are less than three members on the Board of Ethics, to conduct the initial review of applications and make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees to fill vacancies which occur for reasons other than end of term, which authority currently solely rests with the Board of Ethics, (3) limiting consecutive years on the Board of Ethics to eight, to provide consistency with 2026 appointments and the current language limiting terms to two consecutive four-year terms, and (4) with the inclusion of a new paragraph, renumbering the subsections. Public are permitted to attend and provide comments at the above location. Written comments on Local Law No. 1 of 2026 can be submitted to the Village Clerk up and through the time of the public hearing. Budget Requests for Fiscal Year 2027 have been sent out. If you are a Committee/Board/Department and have **not** received a request, please contact the Treasurer's office. Sales Tax Distribution-

- Total February Sales Tax receipts were \$15,221,540. This amount was \$403 thousand (2.73%) **higher** than the \$14.8 million received in February last year.
- Sales Tax 2025 Year-to-date (March to February) was **up** by just over \$9.3 million or 5.43%, from \$172 million for the previous year (2024) to \$172.4 million for the current year (2025).
- The Village of Ballston Spa received \$114,597 on February 20, 2025.
