A Vision Statement describes the desired future state of a community and provides a picture of what the community is working towards. The statement is, therefore, a combination of existing conditions that the community desires to protect and sustain into the future and aspirational elements that the community has not yet achieved but wishes to see manifested in its desired future state. It serves as the organizing feature of the goals and recommendations.

When community members, leaders, and decision makers are confronted with difficult or contentious decisions they can ask themselves, "How does the proposed action support or undermine the community's vision for the future?" The Vision Statement gives life and context to what the "greater good" of the community looks like so that individual and collective actions, competing needs and interests, and decisions big and small can be evaluated based on how they advance the greater good of the entire community.
