Ballston Spa Community Ice Skating

Located at Eastern Avenue in the village (the BARC fields)

Ice skating is free and there are ice skates to borrow (for free) inside the BARC building.

Rules:

- Skaters can only be on the ice during open hours AND when a <u>volunteer is</u> <u>present</u>
- Skaters must have adult supervision
- Skaters must sign in with volunteer before skating
- Skate at your own risk
- No hockey

Skating hours are:

Thursdays 4-7 Fridays 4-7 Saturdays 10-7 Sundays 12-6

If you come by during open hours and we are not open, it means we didn't have a volunteer. We haven't been opening on Thursdays because of lack of interest/volunteers.

COVID safety protocol for BARC building:

Face coverings/masks are required at all times in the BARC building.

There is a supply of masks if anyone needs one to enter the BARC building.

Skaters can borrow skates. Any skates returned will be sanitized before being returned to the shelf.

No sharing of equipment.

The BARC building cannot be used as a warming hut, therefore, there is no congregating inside.

Restrooms are available and will be sanitized at the end of each day of skating.

We always need volunteers! It is quick, easy and fun! Shifts are only one hour long because it is cold outside!

Here are a few things to know if you are interested in volunteering:

You will be asked to wear a vest to make you easily identifiable.

You must have a cell phone on you in case of emergency.

Skaters must sign in with you before skating.

You are there to make sure everyone is having fun and staying safe by following the rules of the ice and the BARC building.
