Mayor Fitzpatrick says, "The transition from one mayor to another and the functioning of the Village government has been seamless. Thank you to Village Staff and the Board of Trustees who made this seamless transition possible."

Progress Update

Infrastructure: Infrastructure is a top priority of the Board and recent efforts include:

• Infrastructure Planning Workshop #1 Nov. 17 – We created an action plan that includes engineering studies this winter and grant proposals this summer – to address water, sewer, and stormwater.

- Completed Village Income Survey to make us more competitive for grants.
- Created Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plan.
- Submitted grant for adding sidewalks, improving intersections, and traffic calming; awards to be announced in early 2022.
- Completed a Tree Inventory to help manage village trees.

Legislation:

- Drafted new zoning for large commercial projects (Planned Development District, or PDD).
- Approved Cannabis (Marijuana) dispensaries and on-site consumption businesses.

Services:

- The Ice-Skating Rink will be at BARC again this year. Thank you to neighborhood volunteers, BARC, and the School District for providing this much-loved winter activity.
- The Committee on the Arts has started a planter decoration project and is planning a wall mural project for the spring stay tuned for updates.
- The Wellness Express provides transportation to medical care for village seniors (60+) please take advantage of this village-funded service and tell your neighbors. 518-399-4624.

Improving Government Communication and Transparency:

- Purchased computer equipment so people can always participate in board meetings from home.
- Instituting annual reports from Village Departments.
