Welcome to the Board of Trustees' newsletter, *The Voice.* We hope you will enjoy reading about upcoming events, and updates on village business.

Upcoming Events

March 15 Special Election – Do not forget to vote! There will be a special election on **Tuesday, March 15th** to choose a Mayor and a Trustee. Polls are open 11 am to 9 pm. North of the Creek, vote at Union Firehouse, South of the Creek, vote at Eagle Matt Lee Firehouse.

Referendum: Voters will also decide on election day whether to change the voting calendar to align with the County Board of Elections ((BOE) so that Village elections will be in November rather than March, and the BOE can run the village elections in the future. This change will save the Village money and staff time and will increase voter turnout. To be enacted, village residents must vote "Yes" on this referendum.

Village Budget Calendar: It is budget time in the village. Budget workshops have just been completed. They were open to the public and held on March 1, 8 and 10. On **April 11** there will be a public hearing to allow input from the public on the proposed budget. The proposed budget will be available to the public on the website in advance of the public hearing. Check the website for this posting.

Updates

Water improvement project moving forward: The next step in improving our water, sewer and stormwater system has been completed. The Board received and reviewed three proposals to develop a plan, which includes the ability to apply for grants to fund improvement and hopes to approve a contract this month. The goal is to apply for multiple grants in 2022. The income study that was completed last year will greatly increase our chances for major grant dollars. For comparison, the Village of Corinth received over \$31 million in grants and zero-interest loans over a seven-year period.

Department Annual Reports now available: As part of our efforts to improve government transparency, village departments presented to the public at Board of Trustee meetings in early 2022. You can watch these year-in-review presentations by clicking on the Village Board meeting videos on the village web site for the following meeting dates: Jan. 10 – Police and Library; Jan 14 – Public Works; Jan. 24 – Building Dept.; Feb. 14 – Treasurer; Feb. 28 – Village Clerk and Village Administrator. Their written reports are also on the web site on their department's pages.

Rickett's Property Cleanup The car wash portion of the property has been removed and Jackson Demolition is working on the dry cleaning/laundry part of the property. The cleanup began in February and is expected to continue for two months. It is being conducted by the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation in consultation with the NYS Department of Health. There is a printed fact sheet on the project available at Village Hall and the Library, and on the website.

Arts Committee – The Committee is working on a Planting Arts Fundraiser, which will kick off in late April. Its new website is up – please check it out - **www.bspaarts.com**. Planning has also started for the Sounds of Summer concerts at the Brookside Museum.

Park and Tree Committee – The Committee has been using the tree inventory to assist DPW and citizens in determining which Village trees should be removed first. The Urban Forestry Inventory and Management Plan, which was funded by a 100% grant, should be completed this spring.

Community Emergency Corps of Ballston Spa - Along with the Saratoga County Sheriff's Office, District 7190, and Ballston Spa and Schenectady Rotary Clubs, donated a decommissioned ambulance to the citizens of Haiti in January. The ambulance was provided to Haiti to help their Emergency Medical Services deal with natural disasters.
